### MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Somethings are not “long-lasting”. Dirty clothes or a messy house requires continued attention. Continual maintenance...

From college until marriage, I smoked a pack-a-day of Marlboro Reds.

Except... I never smoked a cigarette during the month of January. Each year's new year's resolution would be to “quit smoking”.

When I reached the end of the first month of abstinence, I “celebrated” by having one cigarette. One cigarette immediately led to another...

I suspect that many children last month might have attempted to “quit” being naughty. December is a month of appearing “nice” in order to present “good” to Santa. ### Church Council Highlights

The SOV Lutheran Church Council met on Monday, Dec. 15. Here are some highlights of that meeting:

—Pastor John announced that seven new members from the Price and Burnett families, will join our SOV church family, including two that will be baptized.

—Clean-up Day is always the first Saturday of the month. January 3 will mark the first clean-up day of the new year. A clean-up list will be used to prevent doubling up tasks. Council also decided to re-institute our big clean-up weekends twice each year.

—Should the need arise, a box containing a blood pressure kit, a pulsometer, a thermometer, and a church directory is now located in the AV booth at the back of the sanctuary. Many thanks to Don and Susan Gumm for providing these items! If you need to update your emergency contact information, please inform any council member.

—Pledges this year have surpassed those in 2024 by \$19,000 and currently stand at \$72,624.

—Our annual Congregational brunch meeting will take place January 25 after church services.

—Where music is concerned, our services will follow the seasonal Kyrie through December before starting another until Lent begins in February. In addition, Martin Hansen has joined five other pianists/organists who currently “rotate” to provide music for church services.

—Should anyone feel moved to help with the altar guild, or with any volunteering on behalf of the church, please let Pastor John or a council member know. Our stalwart servant Carolyn Stephens will be out for a considerable amount of time as her husband recovers from surgery.

—SOV received a thank you note from the Community Action Agency for the church's help in making the new baby/new mom gift drive a success. SOV was the only church that took part in the effort.
