### **MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR**

In 1948, my father bought my sister's crib on the mezzanine of the Montgomery Ward store at 645 W. Main Street.

Later, the city converted the space into the Merced Multicultural Arts Center which carried the motto, "Arts For All". I was the chair of the design committee and promoted physical accessible accommodations to be "true" to the motto.

When the Center opened, the space offered appropriate accessibility for the offices, galleries, classrooms, corridors, and performance spaces. I was proud of access attention not found in art facilities elsewhere:

- a. The sound/lighting booth being wheelchair accessible.
- b. All support backstage and "green room" is accessible,
- c. The darkroom for photography is accessible,
- d. Mirrors in bathrooms hinged at the bottom to accommodate wheelchair users...

Worship is likewise: access to God is available "for all"!

- a. Gluten-free communion bread is being offered,
- b. Congregation members are providing transportation to worship for those who lack such provision,
- Worship readers can opt to provide worship support from the pews,
- d. Worship presentation is being "tweaked" to allow participation by all to serve,
- e. Modifications are being considered for seating in the sanctuary, and...
- f. Whatever issue which might arise to be considered.

Everyone should feel welcomed. All should feel deserving. All are invited. All are served respectfully.

#### **OUR MISSION**

Our mission is to create a new standard in rescue operation with education and community involvement to end the suffering of animals who are lost, abandoned, or given up to the Merced County shelter.

New Beginnings for Animals – Merced is uniquely well-positioned to accomplish this goal by focusing on our three primary activities:

- Transporting large numbers of animals out of the Merced shelter
- Treating sick/injured abandoned animals and making them available for adoption
- AND working to fund a spay/neuter program in the Merced area to address the root of the overpopulation problem—sterilizing dogs and cats to stop the litters of unwanted animals that are overloading the shelters and rescues.

Please note New Beginnings for Animals Merced County does not have a facility...we are a group of volunteers working out of our homes. All animals are kept in foster homes where available.
